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# Workforce Services Branch

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WSB administers the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), and Wagner Peyser (W-P) Programs.

Prepares adults, youth, and dislocated workers for participation in the workplace.

Connects employers with job openings with qualified job seekers.

Develops up-to-date statistical information, demographics, and analysis impacting the state's business climate.

# Workforce Services

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Covers San Diego, Imperial, and Orange Counties, the Inland Empire, and the Southern Central Valley.

Provides employment services and job service assistance for job seekers and employers through the America's Job Center of California<sup>SM</sup> locations in each respective area.

Represents EDD on local Workforce Development Boards.

Oversees veterans' programs at the local level.

Coordinates the delivery of Trade Adjustment Assistance services.

# Trade Adjustment Assistance (TAA)

Federal program that assists U.S workers who have lost or may lose their jobs as a result of outsourcing.

Provides affected workers with opportunities to obtain the skills, credentials, resources, and support necessary to be reemployed.



# Migrant Seasonal Farmworker Outreach Program

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Targets agricultural employers and workers classified as migrant, seasonal, or migrant food-processing workers.

EDD representatives conduct outreach in areas of high agricultural activity to provide recruitment services for employers and job seekers.



# EDD Fidelity Program & Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)

Provides bonding services at no cost to employers, employees, and job seekers at America's Job Center of California <sup>SM</sup>.



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WOTC promotes the hiring of individuals who qualify as members of a target group, by providing a federal tax credit incentive up to \$9,600 for employers who hire them.

# Youth Employment Opportunity Program

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YEOP provides services to youth ages 15 through 25, to assist them in achieving their educational and vocational goals.

Emphasizes education, assessment, and peer advising.
